

In the original photo, my kids were skiing down the mountain. To modify the image, I used both the Lasso Tool and the Rectangular Marquee Tool to perform four generative fills, removing four skiers and a ski rail. This allowed me to experiment with the tool and create a clean area for adding text. I intentionally left one skier in the foreground to maintain visual interest and positioned the text block just below the image.

I added a rectangular shape with the text 'Learn to ski today!' to simulate an advertisement. My overall goal for this project was to approach it from a marketing perspective—designing an image that could inspire others to want to learn how to ski.
